The work of our Member Committees forms the foundation of WPC's advocacy work and directly drives our position on national issues on behalf of the waterpower industry. - WPC also undertakes research, including that enabled by funding granted by Natural Resources Canada. In 2023, WPC undertook a series of comprehensive studies for hydropower in Canada. These projects discuss the value-added capabilities provided by hydropower in the Canadian electricity system, outline the potential for pumped-storage hydropower in Canada, identify the additional hydropower capability available in the current fleet, discuss the cost of energy sources and introduce the value of services provided by hydropower compared to variable renewable energy.
